07/01/2001 ENHANCEMENTS TO LIDS

The Compensation Board is committed to notifying users of any 07/01/2001 enhancements to LIDS as soon as we know about them. The General Assembly convened on January 11, 2001. This year's session will adjourn on February 24, 2001. We will notify you of any new requirements or updates that result from this year's General Assembly session as soon as the session is over.

Many of the enhancements listed below came from LIDS Users or out of the LIDS Advisory Committee meetings that will be into affect 07/01/2001:

New Forms Maintenance Reports: Commits vs. Releases, Average Daily Population (ADP), and Quarterly Voucher comparisons

New Inquiry Options: ability to view quarterly vouchers and insurance number inquiry.

DNA: recording DNA information will be required.

Certification Message: attached to the monthly certification screen will be a screen containing a comparison of the previous months LIDS data to the current months LIDS data.

In addition to the yearly LIDS Users Guide, the Compensation Board is in the process of developing an Audit Manual. Both the LIDS Users Guide and the new Audit Manual will be available on the Compensation Board's website prior to 07/01/2001.

ANNUAL LIDS TRAINING 2001

The Compensation Board will have it's annual LIDS Training session this coming up **June 2001**. This year's training sessions will be designed as Refresher ONLY.

The training sessions will be held in the **Hanover** and

Lynchburg areas.

Users will receive information concerning the training locations, dates, and training topics in the up coming months.

Also, the July 1, 2001 LIDS Batch Layout will be available on the Compensation Board's website the beginning of April 2001. Please advise your program vendors to visit our website for the July 1 updates.

LIDS Training every 3rd Wednesday of each month. Basic training is held in Richmond. See the CB's website for details on monthly training.

SECUREID

All state agencies, including the Compensation Board, developed productivity savings plans to reduce costs in FY01 and beyond by capturing efficiencies generated by technology and other sources. In line with Virginia's goals of electronic government and the efficiencies it can provide, access to our SNIP and LIDS systems will change for dial-in users from the current toll free dial-in access to your local Internet access. Using the Internet, users will access the two systems via the Compensation Board's website home page.

This change will go into effect July 1, 2001 and will require the use of a security product, SecurID. SecurID is one of the leaders in remote authentication and is heavily used in the banking and manufacturing industries and is also used by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

This change will affect only offices that access SNIP or LIDS using the dial-up toll free connection provided by the Compensation Board. A dial-up connection is utilized if the first username

entered in your logon procedures is 'compbd'. If you do not enter 'compbd' as the first entry of your logon procedures, you are not using the Compensation Board provided toll free dial-up connection and this change does not affect your office at this time. Training will be conducted in March, April, and May. **Additional information will be forth coming**


Dear All LIDS Users:
