BUDGET UPDATES PROPOSED PER DIEM FUNDING

The Governor's proposed FY05/06 budget, submitted on December 17, 2003, recommends increasing per diem reimbursements by \$6,012,965 in FY05 and \$9,075,267 in FY06. In addition, the Governor's recommended amendments to the current year budget include an additional per diem amount of \$1,320,819. These amounts correspond to the projected inmate population growth based on jail forecasting percentages for the current year and the upcoming biennium. However, these increases do not address the restoration of FY04 per diem reductions that total \$13,320,293 in each year.

In the current fiscal year (FY04), we project that fourth quarter per diem payments will be reduced by 81%. For example, if your inmate population in the 4th Quarter results in per diems of \$100,000, an 81% reduction would mean that your city/county will only receive \$19,000. Unless these funds are restored by the General Assembly, similar reductions can be expected in FY05 and FY06.

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**FY02 JAIL COST REPORT
AVAILABLE ON COMPENSATION BOARD WEBSITE**

The fifth annual Jail Cost Report (FY02) prepared by the Compensation Board as required by the provisions of Item 63.L.1 - 63.L.3. of Chapter 1042, 2003 Acts of Assembly is now available on the Compensation Board's website, <http://www.scb.virginia.gov> under Publications and Forms.

The Compensation Board is required to annually prepare a report detailing all expenditures and revenues of Virginia's local and regional jails and jail farms. This report contains those items for FY2002 along with a brief profile of each facility and its operating environment. New in this year's report is an appendix which displays inmate canteen and other fund revenues and expenditures. The report also displays the flow of federal revenue in funding Virginia's jails. We have included comparative data for fiscal years 2000 and 2001.

HB235 State Compensation Board



It is possible that the following statutory language **could** occur and will affect the Local Inmate Data System (LIDS):

State Compensation Board. Requires the State Compensation Board to (i) maintain in the Local Inmate Data System (LIDS) specific data fields for an inmate's country of birth and country of citizenship, (ii) require all jail facilities that are subject to LIDS reporting to complete the additional fields for all inmates housed at such facilities, (iii) annually encourage all jail facilities subject to LIDS reporting to request compensation from the United States Department of Justice State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) for costs associated with incarcerating undocumented aliens; (iv) provide information to all jail facilities on the eligibility requirements to obtain such funds; and (v) monitor local jail participation in the SCAAP program.
