HELD FOR LOCALITY

If the inmate is being held for another locality within the state then the "Held for Locality" should accurately reflect the jurisdiction / locality for which the inmate is being held.

This field is often used by Agencies and other groups doing jail expansion plans as they relate to bed space needs. Therefore, it is very important to record the FIPS code correctly.

This is the locality for which you are holding an inmate.

This is a required field and must be a valid FIPS.

If the inmate is being held for federal or out of state authorities you should use 801-888.

New Policy Manager Selected

Meredith Farrar-Owens accepted the position as the Compensation Board's Policy Manager in October.

Meredith's responsibilities include LIDS auditing and Jail Cost reporting for the agency. She will work with the General Assembly, evaluating the impact of proposed legislation, policies, and regulations. Additionally, Meredith will direct the agency's strategic planning activities and jail population forecasting efforts.

Prior to her joining the Compensation Board management team, Meredith worked for ten years with the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission, where she had been Deputy Director since 1999. At the Department of Criminal Justice Services, she forecasted local jail populations and served as technical staff for Governor Allen's Commission on Parole Abolition and Sentencing Reform. The work of the Governor's Commission resulted in comprehensive and sweeping reform of Virginia's criminal justice system in 1994. While at the Department of Corrections, Meredith forecasted inmate populations and assisted in agency planning.

Meredith is a graduate of the University of Virginia, where she received a Bachelor of Arts degree in economics with a minor in government. Meredith completed her Master's Degree in sociology at Virginia Commonwealth University.
