SUBJECT: Compensation Board Approved Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2009 (FY10)

Your Compensation Board Budget for FY2010 is now available in the COIN Budget Request Subsystem. This budget has been approved subject to the provisions of the 2009 Virginia Acts of Assembly. This memorandum also serves as official notification that the Compensation Board, in accordance with §15.2-1636.8, Code of Virginia, has fixed the salaries and expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.

For Sheriffs and Regional Jails, please be advised that the approval of your budget for FY10 is contingent upon the Compensation Board's receipt of federal stimulus funds approved by the 2009 General Assembly, and contingent upon agreement by your local government administrator to accept the federal stimulus funds, as explained in a communication from the Compensation Board Executive Secretary on April 24, 2009.

Please note that your right as a Constitutional Officer to file a notice of appeal, pursuant to §15.2-1636.9, Code of Virginia, originates from the date of this memorandum. Any communication(s) subsequent to this memorandum does not extend the period within which you may file your notice of appeal. Similarly, any objection filed by a governing body pursuant to §15.2-1636.8, Code of Virginia, commences from this date and is not extended by any subsequent communication(s).

Please note that you will not receive a paper copy of your Compensation Board budget. However, you can download and print a copy of your approved budget from the COIN Budget Request Subsystem. Also, your budget is available for review on the Compensation Board website.
